**Papermaker Preschool - Enrollment for Fall 09-10 Opens March 16, 2009!**

Camas High School's Papermaker Preschool is open to children who are four years of age by August 31, 2009. The morning session runs 8:45-11:15 a.m. and the afternoon session runs 12:45-3:15 p.m. The full-time preschool hours are 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Tuition is \$230 per month, pro-rated September through May, for part-time preschoolers and \$690 per month for full-time (nine-hour maximum/day) preschoolers. Our integrated, developmental preschool follows the Camas School District Calendar.
