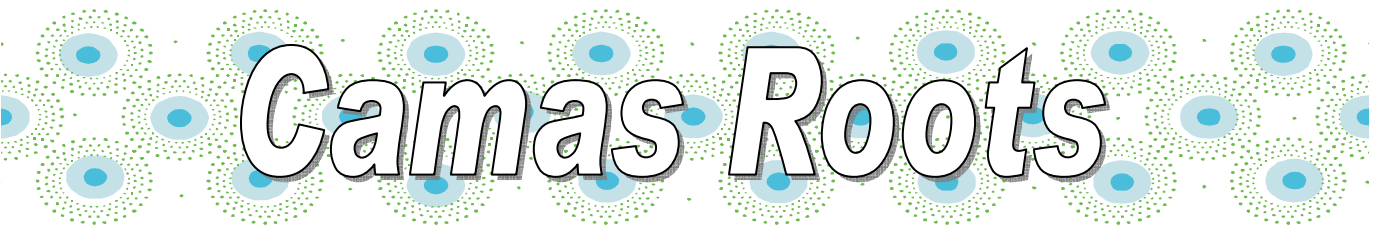

Camas Extended Day Program Open Enrollment Begins May 1st!

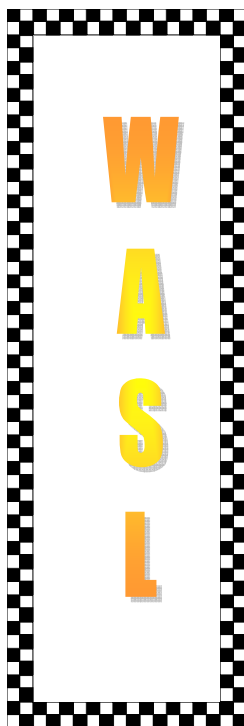

The program provides a nurturing and secure environment for children before and after school. S.T.A.R.S. accredited staff provide outdoor/gym recreational activities, arts, crafts, supervised free-choice, homework help and opportunities for developing social skills within large groups, small groups, multi-age and a multi-cultural setting. The Kindergarten-Too program supports Kindergarten learning by offering additional opportunities for social development and fine and gross motor skill refinement. 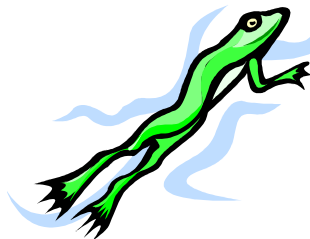
