10th Annual CEF Auction a Success!

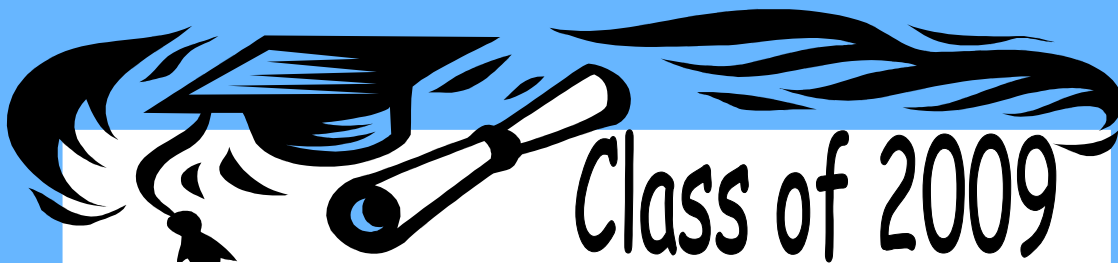
