The Camas School District Citizens Advisory Committee is seeking new members. Formed as an advisory group to the Camas School Board and Superintendent, CAC allows school district patrons to have input into school programs, policies, and issues. The following questions and answers below will provide more information about the CAC. If you are interested in possible membership after reviewing the information, please fully complete the attached application and return it to the address indicated by September 29, 2023. We also invite you to visit the October 2, 2023, meeting at the Zellerbach Administration Center in the Dennison Boardroom at 5:30 PM as a guest.

The CAC is a representative cross-section of 25 parent and non-parent patrons of the Camas School District. We appoint members from each <u>director district</u> representing students of varying grade levels and demographics of our community. This year, we seek two members from District 1, two members from District 2, two members from District 3, one member from District 4, and two members from District 5.

What are some of the issues which CAC will address?

It varies yearly; areas covered in the past include boundary revisions, school start times, long-range planning, student safety, and bond planning. The meeting agendas vary each month based on issues brought to the committee by the Board and individual committee members.

How often does CAC meet?

CAC meets on the first Monday of the month (October - June) at 5:30 PM at the Zellerbach Administration Center in the Dennison Board room when not in remote learning.

What are the qualifications for membership?

Membership requires only residency in the school district and a sincere interest in education. Nominated members receive a formal appointment from the School Board and serve a three-year term.
